

**THE CERTIFICATE IN PRE-HEALTH SCIENCE GREYMOUTH
MASONIC LODGE AWARD**

The annual Certificate in Pre-Health Science Greymouth Masonic Lodge Award was established in 2009 from an initial disbursement of \$3,000 gifted by the Greymouth Lodge 1233 English Constitution, Charitable Trust to run the award for three years.

The Awards Committee of Tai Poutini Polytechnic has assumed responsibility for administering the award.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- (1) The award is to be known as the Greymouth Lodge Award.
- (2) Two awards will be made annually to students of the Certificate in Pre-Health Science at Tai Poutini Polytechnic.
- (3) Students wishing to apply for this award should complete an Application Form including obtaining a Referee's Statement from their Programme Co-ordinator.
- (4) The recipients will be chosen on the basis of:
 - An evidence-based financial need and,
 - A high probability of successful completion.
- (5) Presentation of the award is to take place at the annual awards ceremony.
- (6) If, in the opinion of the Academic Board, no candidate of sufficient merit is nominated in any one year, no award is to be made for that year.
- (7) There will be two awards of \$500.00 annually.
- (8) The award is made for the sole purpose of defraying expenses incurred in the pursuit of education in the year of presentation of the award.
- (8) The Certificate in Pre-Health Science Programme Co-ordinator and Head of Department, and the Students' Association at Tai Poutini Polytechnic are to receive notification of the terms and conditions of the award.
- (9) The Greymouth Lodge 1233 English Constitution is to be advised of the name of the successful nominees for the award, and a representative will be invited to the graduation ceremony to present the award.
- (10) The decision of the Award Committee is final and no review will be undertaken.
- (11) The Students' Association and tutors should encourage applications from students by 10 March.
